Adaptive Learning


Individualized programmed instruction with dynamic, immediate, process-oriented feedback and assessment


History and Theoretical Foundations

Behaviorism: Operant Conditioning-Skinner (1953)

Not Species Dependent

Child's behavior is a function of "automatic reinforcement." Desired behavior is rewarded, undesired behavior is punished.

Skinner's teaching machine



Cognitive Psyc: Vygotsky's ZPD (1934) Zone of proximal development (Learner can do with guidance)

Learner can do unaided

Learner cannot do

ZPD:

- Internal
- Cannot be observed
- Change in knowledge
- Transforming existing knowledge

- Previous knowledge determines pathway
 - Objective to improve learning, create change

Operant Conditioning

- Behavior change through conditioning
- External stimuli
- Observable change
- Sequential





Advantages

- Adaptive dynamic assessments (Wu, 2017; Simon-Campbell & Phelan, 2016)
 - Immediate feedback
 - Customized items
 - Reduce length of test and time
 - Decreased anxiety
 - o Identifies areas for remediation
 - Positive results from primary through calculus level students.
- Delivery

Disadvantages

- Missing social learning context (this is changing)
- Effectiveness of reinforcement derives from work done with animals (Carini, 1961)
- What is positive reinforcement?
- Motivation (Simon-Campbell & Phelan,, 2016).
- Arguable problems with extrinsic rewards (Eisenberger & Cameron, 1996)
